

Show your children these candies and have them figure out the connection to Pesach

1. mega button candies- the plague of boils
2. gummy fish-the fish died in the Nile during the plague of blood
3. safari candies (or plague animals)-the animals died during the plague of dever
4. marshmallow with a swirl-during the plague of barad, there was fire and water
5. Fruit Candy-when we left Mitzrayim and crossed through the ים סוף, as a sign of love, Hahsem had fruit coming out of the walls of water
6. Marshmallow Filled Chocolate Locusts-there was a plague of locusts
7. Passover Flip Frog (there are also chocolate frogs) Toy-there was a plague of frogs
8. chocolate non parils,-the white is for lice, the colored ones represent har siani, which is why we left Mitzrayim to get to Har Siani, which had flowers on them
9. "semi circle" fruit slices, Tosof's says, that when we left Mitzrayim and Hashem split the sea, we actually ended up on the same side as when we left, we went through the Nile, in a "semi circle"
10. chocolate baby fingers-or regular lady fingers-by the plague of lice, the magicians said that "it was the finger of Hashem", there is also a connection in the Hagada between the 10 plagues and the 10 fingers, כַּמָּה לָקוּ בְּאַצְבַּע עֶשֶׂר מַכּוֹת. אָמֹר מֵעַתָּה, בְּמִצְרַיִם לָקוּ עֶשֶׂר מַכּוֹת וְעַל הַיָּם לָקוּ הַמִּשְׁשִׁים מַכּוֹת
11. non parils chocolate-lice
12. blood oranges-the blood penetrated the fruit
13. sour apple candies- The medrash says that the women would give birth under the apple trees.
